**PRIZE LIST AND SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ANNUAL
PRIZE DAY**

ACADEMIC PRIZES

1. General Proficiency

- a) **Grade 1 -3**
 - All students with an average of 80% and above.
 - Pass in all subjects
- b) **Grade 4-10**
 - All students with an average of 75% and above.
 - Pass in all subjects.
- c) **Grade 11 & 12**
 - All students with an average of 80% and above.
 - Pass in all subjects.

2. Subject Prize

- This prize will be awarded to students from Grade 4 to 12.
- Awarded to the student(s) with highest aggregate mark of not less than 75% from each subject taught in grade 4 to 10. For students of grade 11 and 12 aggregate mark must be not less than 80%.
- Selected from whole grade and not from each class.

3. Class Prize

- This prize will be awarded to students from Grade 4 to 12.
- The best average of the class not less than an average of 50.

4. Class Progress Prize

- This prize will be awarded to students from Grade 4 to 12.
- Pass in all subjects.
- Awarded to the students from each class who had shown the greatest improvement in the average mark from term to term for two terms.
 - ***Steps which could be followed***
 - a) *Find out the students who have shown improvement in the average mark from Term 1 to Term 2 (average of term 1- average of term 2 >0)*
 - b) *The student(s) who has shown the greatest improvement will be awarded the prize.*
 - ❖ *Note: The final aggregate mark should not be used as Term 2 mark.*

5. Honour listed Award

- This prize will be awarded to students from Grade 4 to 12
- Pass in all subjects.
- Aggregate not less than 85%.

- The prizes for Scout/Guide with best academic performance will be awarded to the guide and the scout with the highest aggregate not less than 75%.
- Best all round scout/guide will be selected by a committee appointed by the Principal. The guidelines to nominate and select candidates will be designed by the co-curricular section and approved by Principal.
- Students for International, National and Inter school Awards category will be selected based on the given criteria above.
- The prizes for prefect with best academic performance (junior & prefect separately) will be awarded to the prefect with the highest aggregate not less than 75%.
- The prizes for best all round prefect will be selected by a committee appointed by the Principal. The guidelines to nominate and select candidates will be designed by the prefect board and approved by Principal
- The student for the prize of best student in co-curricular activities will be selected by a committee appointed by the Principal. The guidelines to nominate and select candidates will be designed by the prefect board and approved by Principal

DISCIPLINE AWARD

- One from each class, selected by the class teacher and the subject teachers over seen by the grade Leading Teacher. The class teacher will make five nominations for whom the class teacher and subject teachers will give score as follows. Average of the scores will determine individual score. The student(s) with highest score from each class will get this prize.

MOST HELPFUL STUDENTS

- Students for this award will be selected by a selection committee appointed by the Principal. Students will be selected based on the criteria designed by the Prefect Board and Co-curricular section. Students who score best 10 scores will be selected as most helpful students to the school.

SPECIAL PRIZES

1. Best Ten Results at school Level (O'level)

- The students are to be ranked according to their performance in curriculum subject at GCE O/L and SSC exam. Points awarded according to scale mention below.

A=12, B= 9, C=7, D = 5

- Students with the same total share the placement rank.

2. Best Five Results at school Level (A 'level)

- The students are to be ranked according to their performance in curriculum subject at GCE A/L and HSC exam. Points awarded according to scale mention below.

$$A=12, \quad B= 9, C=7, D = 5, E=3$$

- Students with the same total share the placement rank.

3. Special Award for Best Results at National Level

- This prize will be awarded to students from this school who are ranked in National Top Ten Results at GCE O/L, SSC & GCE A/L, and HSC.

4. Distinctions at GCE A/L, O/L, SSC and HSC Exam

- Students with distinctions in any of curriculum subject at the above mentioned exams will be awarded this prize.

5. Award for the Best House in Studies

- This prize will be awarded to the house with the best academic score.
- To calculate academic score, the aggregate total of all students in the house will be divided by the number of students to get the aggregate average (academic score).

$$\text{Aggregate Total/ Number of students in the house} = \text{Academic Score}$$

6. Award for the Best House in Co-curricular Activities

- This prize will be awarded to the house with highest points from the sports activities and other co-curricular activities.
- Here only points from inter house events held during course of the year will be considered.
- Points are awarded according to the scale below:

$$1^{\text{st}} \text{ place} = 5 \text{ points, } 2^{\text{nd}} \text{ Place} = 3 \text{ points, and } 3^{\text{rd}} \text{ Place} = 1 \text{ point.}$$

- Points according the above scale will be given for each inter- house activity, and the total from all activities will be calculated.

7. Award for the Best All-Round House

- This prize will be awarded to the house with highest combined total of both academic score and sports points. (mentioned above. Refer 5 & 6).

8. Best Academic Performance Primary

- This prize will be awarded to the student(s) from grade 5 with highest average in the final term of the year (*from aggregate marks sheet only*).

9. Best Academic Performance Middle School

- This prize will be awarded to the student(s) from grade 7 with highest average in the final term of the year (*from aggregate marks sheet only*).

10. Best Academic Performance Secondary

- This prize will be awarded to the student(s) from grade 10 with highest average in the final term of the year (*from aggregate marks sheet only*).

11. Best Academic Performance Higher Secondary

- This prize will be awarded to the student(s) from grade 12 with highest average in the final term of the year (*from aggregate marks sheet only*).

12. Award for the Best All- Round Student

- The student for this award will be selected among students from grade 10 and 12.
- A set of forms (forms A – E) will be filled by the school for the best 10 students from SSC/O’level exam and best 5 students from HSC/A ‘level Exam. The Forms are as shown in the Annex A – E
- The student for this award will be selected by a committee appointed by the Principal. The Committee will be headed by the Principal or the Deputy Principal, In charge of academic Section
